

NAPA RIVER ECOLOGY CENTER REUSE & IMPROVE

- Adaptive reuse project located along the Napa River Wetlands
- Repurposes existing 5,000 square foot building and surrounding three acre parcel
- Removes blight and improves wetlands habitat
- Beautifies the neighborhood
- Generates new education, recreation, and tourism opporunities
- Future kayak launch access to Napa River
- New green demonstration features
- Located along San Francisco Bay Trail





EXPAND YOUTH EDUCATION

- A new hub for outdoor science and hands-on learning, the Eco Center will allow the Foundation to quadruple program capacity and reach
- Environmental science workforce development program build the next generation of STEM science professionals

NEW PUBLIC ACCESS

- The project creates .5 miles of new walking paths and wetlands viewing areas
- Outdoor classrooms, wildlife viewing deck
- Future kayak launch
- Removes blight and beautifies the neighborhood

CLIMATE RESILENCY

- Protects and enhances sensitive wetlands habitat
- Buffers future sea level rise
- Enhances endangered wildlife species habitat



The Foundation leads a robust community outreach process to plan and design the center


Funding and Design

Private, Government, and Coprporate funding supports early phases of development

Design permit and lease agreement apporved by the City

Ground Breaking & Opening

With \$3,000,000 of the estimated \$8,000,000 project costs in place, ground breaking is scheduled for Fall 2025 and opening a year later
