Baseline Budget

- Overhead
 - Board, minutes, agency coordination, Restoration Authority/IRWMP/BARR staff support [In-Kind MMWD, SCWA, Novato San] \$ 68,986
- General Benefit
 - Outreach, website, JTC and Communication Committees, Watershed Council,
 - \$116,304
- Specific Benefit Projects from Estimated Carryover [projects] \$80,000
- \$185,290 BUDGET Total [plus \$80,000 project funds carryover]

Proposed Budget: Highlights

- Same as 2016/17 dues
- Staff costs remain same
- Set-aside \$12,500 for 2018 conference:
 - total \$25K to be used for expenses result: *reduced member cost for 2018 conference support*
 - \$12,500 FY 2016/17 + \$12,500 FY 20017/18 + Outside Sponsorship + Registration Fees
- \$80K in new [carryover] funds for specific projects/conference if needed
- As in past, contingency allows flexibility
